

Changes from Instruction Booklet v1 to Instruction Booklet v2

- Individual Playoffs (page 5): The puzzle pool will have 35 puzzles instead of 32.
- Round 1 (Welcome): Puzzles 1.8 and 1.9 have been renamed Tangled Words 1 and 2.
- Round 1 (Welcome): In 1.3 Alphametic, a sentence “Multi-digit numbers cannot start with a 0” has been added.
- Round 2 (Assorted Puzzles): The instructions for 2.18 Japanese Sums and Products have been fixed: “For each row and column the numbers outside are shown in correct order.”
- Round 6 (Patches): A sentence “For each puzzle, the score is rounded down to the nearest integer” has been added.
- Round 7 (Worms): The following paragraph has been added: “For this round, no alternative notation can be used, only numbers in cells will be accepted. It is fine to enter numbers from different directions, though.”
- Round 14 (Jigsaw Kropki): A sentence “All four rotations of the correct solutions will be accepted” has been added.
- World Cup Round 3: Fixed the example of Z12 BACAA.
- World Cup Round 3: Rephrased the instructions to Z4 New Tren (no substantial changes).
- World Cup Round 3: Replaced the example to Z4 New Tren.
- World Cup Round 3: The instructions for Z3 Japanese Sums have been fixed: “For each row and column the numbers outside are shown in correct order.”
- Team Playoffs: Fixed the region sizes in the example to Knapp Daneben Lookouts.
- Team Playoffs: Fixed the examples to Coded Tetrominoes and Coded Japanese Sums.
- Team Playoffs: In Coded Tetrominoes, a sentence “Tetrominoes can be rotated but not reflected.” has been added.
- Team Playoffs: The instructions for Coded Japanese Sums have been fixed: “For each row and column the numbers outside are shown in correct order.”
- Team Playoffs: In the Pento Words example, the list of words has been added.
